There are a growing number of Marxists today. By which I mean followers of Groucho. not Karl. "Whatever it is, I'm against it," Marx sang in his 1932 film, "Horse Feathers." He goes on; "I don't know what they have to say, it makes no

difference anyway." A surprisingly prescient take on the modern world, I think. Such cynicism (suspicion regarding another's intent) makes it very difficult for stories of Good News to get a hearing and, I suspect, makes us miserable in the long term.

The original Cynics were a school of Greek philosophy. They were certainly cynical, but they were cynical that the values of their age; the

pursuit of possessions, pleasure, power and prestige, could ever lead to lasting satisfaction. They set a higher standard for human fulfillment.

At Christmas we hear the story of God becoming one of us, disarming the arguments of God not knowing what life is like, of God being far off, of God not showing vulnerability. God becomes present in the midst of all the crazy, dangerous, funny and beautiful stuff that makes for human life. And nothing is ever the same again.
